### **1. JURISDICTION**

This event is a National Race Meeting, promoted by the Taupo Car Club Inc. at Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park, Taupo

- Appendix Two, Schedule A - Driver Safety and Vehicle Requirements,

### **3. RACE MEETING DATES ENTRY CLOSING DATES, ENTRY FEES & ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY**

#### **2.1. Race Meeting Dates:**

- Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2018 Track 2

#### **2.2. Entry Closing Dates:**

The entry closing dates for each round will be the Tuesday before the event.

#### **2.3. Entry Fees (include GST):**

The entry fee is **\$150.00** (incl GST & hire transponder if required) per round.

The late entry fee of **\$180.00** (incl GST & transponder if required) for entries received after the closing date or those who enter on the day.

#### **2.4. Acceptance of Entry:**

Given that this is a 'low key' no formal acceptance of entry will be posted. Competitors can therefore assume that provided they have completed an Entry Form fully and included with it the appropriate entry fee that the organisers will accept the entry.

Competitors may enter on the day, however this incur the Late Entry Fee of \$180.00.

### **3. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS AND UNDERSTANDING:**

#### **3.1. Licence Requirements:**

The driver must hold as a minimum a C Grade Competition or higher  
If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required

#### **Competitor Briefing:**

A verbal Drivers Briefing will be held outside the documentation office on the Sunday morning at **9.30am**.  
It is essential that you attend as a roll call may be held.

#### **3.2. New Drivers:**

Any driver who has not previously competed at the Taupo Motor Race Circuit must indicate the fact on the entry form and attend the New Competitors Briefing session. The time and place for this briefing will be in Race Control immediately following the Verbal Drivers Briefing

#### **3.3. Competitor Understanding:**

In signing the entry form competitors (Entrants and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and Competitors obligations and
- Schedule Z articles detailing Flag signals and the Code of Conduct.

### **4. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION**

#### **Documentation:**

Will be held in the Documentation Room on the Ground floor **from 08.30 – 09:30**

Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle is to be subjected to an audit. You should assume that your vehicle is going to be subjected to audit and as a consequence is in readiness to be taken

#### **Scrutineering:**

Will be held on the hard stand from 08:30 – 09:30.

### **5. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT AND ORGANISERS RIGHTS**

The organisers reserve the right to cancel or abandon the meeting or part thereof should less than 20 entries be received.

For reasons of Force Majeure should a meeting or part thereof be cancelled any entry fee refunds will be made at the discretion of the organisers

### **6. TRANSPONDER TIMING**

Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. If you need to hire one then in signing for the transponder you will be liable for:

- Paying the transponder hire fee and/or.
- Any loss or damage to the transponder

If you own your own transponder please ensure the transponder number is recorded on your entry form. No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is fitted correctly.

### **7. RACE FORMATS:**

- Qualifying – 15 minutes sessions
  - Race 1 (6 laps) Grid Start
  - Race 2 (6 laps) Handicap Starts
  - Race 3 (6 laps) Handicap Starts
- Best lap of Qualifying  
Best of lap of Qualifying and/or Race 1  
Best of lap of Qualifying and/or Race 1 & 2

### **8. VEHICLE AND CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:**

#### **Safety Harnesses**

Safety Harnesses Requirements - 3 strap (lap and diagonal) NZTA accepted standards

#### **Roll Protection**

- Closed vehicles (not road registered) Safety Cage – optional Safety Roll bar - mandatory
- Closed vehicles (road registered) Safety Cage – optional Safety Roll bar – optional

### FUEL

- No Fuel is available at the circuit. Please be note that you cannot store fuel in your pits overnight

### PROGRAMME

This will be available at the documentation office after qualifying and race group have been allocated.

### PIT PADDOCK AND COMPETITION SURFACE RULES

- Dogs are NOT allowed within the Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park grounds.
- No person under the age of 16 is allowed in the Pit Lane/Dummy Grid areas.
- Closed toed shoes MUST be worn in the Pit Lane/Dummy Grid areas.
- The entire area from the ticketing gates to the race circuit is SMOKE FREE. Smoking is only permitted in the spectator stands and the grass area in the pit paddock
- Children's Bicycles, Skateboards and Scooters may be confiscated if considered to be dangerous and a nuisance. They will be returned at the conclusion of the days' event.
- Nothing is to be hammered into the Pit Paddock seal. If you are observed doing this you will be asked to remove them and charged with the repair costs.
