1. ANNOUNCEMENT & JURISDICTION:

The Winter Dual Sprint Series is organised by the Taupo Car Club Incorporated. The meetings are held under the National Sporting Code of Motorsport New Zealand, current manual or Manual 35 & any relevant Appendices & Schedules relating thereto.

4. ENTRY FEES:

The entry fee is **\$100.00** (incl GST & hire transponder if required) per round.

The late entry fee of **\$130.00** (incl GST & transponder if required) for entries received after the closing date or those who enter on the day.

5. **The VENUE:** Track 2, Bruce McLaren Motorsport Park, corner of Broadlands Rd & Centennial Dr, Taupo

6. **RACE MEETING DATE:** Saturday 16th June 2018 :

7. **CLOSING DATES FOR ENTRIES:** Will the Tuesday before each Round

8. **ENTRY CRITERIA:** Acceptance of entries will be at the organiser's discretion. They must be on the official entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee. Closing dates will be enforced & late entries will only be accepted at the organiser's discretion accompanied by an additional entry fee of \$30.00. Entries will be processed on a first come first entered basis. A maximum limit of 70 entries. Dual entries (1 car & 2 drivers) will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.

9. **ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES:** Will NOT be sent out.

10. **LICENCE REQUIREMENTS:** All Dual Sprint competitors must hold a minimum of a Temporary M Grade or higher competition licence. Temporary M grade licences may be purchased from the Motorsport NZ Steward on the day. A test is required.

11. **CLASS REQUIREMENTS:** This class is primarily intended as an entry-level event for novice & inexperienced competitors.
A maximum of 12 cars (6 rows of 2) will be on the circuit at any one time. Over driving or aggressive driving will result in exclusion from the event. Competitors will be grouped fastest to slowest based on their lap times

on the day.

- One 3 lap Practice & Three x 3 lap timed runs. More runs if time permitting.

- 12. SERIES POINTS SYSTEM:** Competitors will be awarded points based on their own improvement in performance, lap times, throughout the individual rounds of the series. This means we intend to reward driving performance & not necessarily vehicle performance improvements.
- 20 points will be awarded for the greatest improvement on the day in a descending order to 18th place being awarded 2 points then 1 point for all other cars.
- 13. VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS:** All competing vehicles & competitor safety equipment must comply conform to the requirements laid down in Motor Sport New Zealand Manual No 35, Schedule A. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in exclusion from the meeting. SLICKS ALLOWED
- 14. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING:**
Documentation: Will be held in the Documentation Office on the ground floor from 08:30 - 09.30.
Scrutineering: Will be held at the Scrutineering Shed from 08:30 – 09.30.
** Please note ** All cars that do not have a logbook will be scrutineered at each event.
- 15. DRIVERS BRIEFING:** This will be held for at 9.30am sharp outside the Documentation Office. Attendance is compulsory for all competitors.
- 16. CANCELLATION / ABANDONMENT:** The organisers reserve the right to postpone or abandon the event in part or in full, in consultation with the Motorsport NZ steward/s. The organisers further reserve the right to cancel the event if less than 40 entries are received by the stated close of entry dates listed above.
- 17. REFRESHMENTS:** Refreshments will be available at the Taupo Car Club Clubrooms at completion of day.
- 18. TRANSPONDER TIMING:** Timing for the meeting is by the AMB transponder system. If you need to hire one then in signing for the transponder you will be liable for:
- Paying the transponder hire fee and/or.
 - Any loss or damage to the transponder
- If you own your own transponder please ensure the number is recorded on your entry form.
No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your transponder is fitted correctly.
- 19. RESULTS:** These will be available throughout the day. Series results will be posted at the next event & on the club website as soon as practical after the event.
- 20. GENERAL INFORMATION - PIT LANE & COMPETITION RACE SURFACE**
- Dogs are NOT allowed within the Taupo Motorsport Park grounds
 - No person under the age of 16 is allowed in the Pit Lane & Dummy Grid areas
 - Closed toed shoes MUST be worn in the Pit Lane & Dummy Grid areas.
 - The entire area from the ticketing gates to the race circuit is SMOKE FREE. Smoking is only permitted in the spectator stands & the grass area in the pit paddock
 - Children's Bicycles, Skateboards & Scooters may be confiscated if considered a nuisance & dangerous & will be returned at the conclusion of the days' event.
 - Nothing is to be hammered into the Pit Paddock seal. If you are observed doing this you will be asked to remove them & charged with the repair costs.
